

Massachusetts System of Assurance of Net Metering Eligibility

Public Entity 10 MW Cap Tracking

Per D.P.U. 12-01-A at 18, the maximum amount of net metering generating capacity eligible for net metering by a municipality or other governmental entity is 10 MW. The list below tracks all D.P.U. approved Public Entities' progress against the 10 MW limit. Only projects where a Public Entity is listed as the Host Customer Entity are included in these calculations. The data provided below reflects the best available estimate at the time of access of capacity (kW) grandfathered, interconnected, reserved, and pending that is receiving, or eligible to receive, net metering services. "Grandfathered" capacity is consider to be any net metering facility interconnected prior to January 24, 2013, or during the Transitional Period. The accuracy of this data set is limited as adjustments to outstanding Applications for Cap Allocation may occur at any time.
